## ***Monetary Gifts***

Cash contributions are a quick and easy way to show your support for the Tuscarawas County Public Library System. Donor Wall gift amounts are as followed: Bronze Book - \$250, Silver Book - \$500, Gold Book - \$1,000+.

## ***Bequests by Will or Trust***

The simplest way to make a lasting gift to the causes that are important to you during your lifetime is to make a bequest through your will or trust. The bequest can be for a specific dollar amount, a percentage of your estate, or residue of the estate.

## ***Gifts of Real Estate***
